

**TOWNSHIP OF HARDYSTON**

**BOND ORDINANCE STATEMENTS AND SUMMARY**

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, has been finally adopted by the Township of Hardyston, in the County of Sussex, New Jersey, on February 25, 2026 and the twenty (20) day period of limitation within which a suit, action or proceeding questioning the validity of such ordinance can be commenced, as provided in the Local Bond Law, has begun to run from the date of the first publication of this statement. Copies of the full ordinance are available at no cost and during regular business hours at the Clerk's office in the Municipal Building in said Township for members of the general public who request the same. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

Title:	Bond ordinance 2026-01 providing for the acquisition of a new fire command vehicle by the Township of Hardyston, in the County of Sussex, New Jersey, appropriating \$100,000 therefor and authorizing the issuance of \$95,000 bonds or notes of the Township for financing such appropriation.
Purpose(s):	Acquisition, by purchase, of new fire fighting equipment for use by the Hardyston Township Fire Department, including one (1) fire command vehicle.
Appropriation:	\$100,000
Bonds/Notes Authorized:	\$95,000
Grants (if any) Appropriated:	\$0
Section 20 Costs:	\$5,000
Useful Life:	5 years
