**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HARDYSTON, COUNTY OF SUSSEX,  
STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 172,  
VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES  
REGARDING HOLLAND MOUNTAIN ROAD**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Municipal Council of the Township of Hardyston,  
County of Sussex, State of New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Chapter 172, Vehicles and Traffic, Section 172-27, Speed Limits, of  
the aforesaid Revised General Ordinances is hereby amended and supplemented with  
respect to the speed limit on Holland Mountain Road to read as follows:

**§ 172-27. Speed Limits**

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Direction</u>	<u>Speed Limit</u>	<u>Location</u>
Holland Mountain Road	Both	25 mph	From the intersection of NJSH Route 23 for a distance of 225 feet West of Route 23

**SECTION 2.** All ordinances of the Township of Hardyston which are inconsistent  
with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such  
inconsistency.

**SECTION 3.** If any section, subsection, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for  
any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court or competent jurisdiction,  
such decision shall not affect the remaining portion of this ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance may be renumbered for purposes of codification.

**SECTION 5.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage,  
approval and publication as required by law.
